Students - What to tell them when they call.

- Where to find us: Level 6 in Main Building, on Chelmsford Avenue.
- Supervisors name: Simone
- Hours: 8am to 4.30 pm with $\frac{1}{2}$ hour lunch.
- Parking: Either in the multi-storey car park or on the street.
- On the first day arrive at 8.30am and sit in waiting room at the front of Occupational Therapy. Let them know that I will not be there on their first day, but they will be orientated by other staff.
- Uniform: Yes - they need to wear their uniform. Closed in shoes.
- Lunch: Inform them that they can bring their own lunch or buy food at the kiosk.
- Caseload: They will be working in the rehabilitation unit with patients following a stroke or orthopaedic condition. They will also be working in the Day Rehabilitation unit - this is usually with stroke patients.
- What to know before they start: Read up about Stroke and stroke rehabilitation. It would be useful for them to review information about treatment planning and goal setting. They will be learning how to complete initial assessments, MBI, MMSE and Upper Limb Assessments, as well as a variety of cognitive and perceptual Ax.
- Could they please bring: personal Learning Goals and their checklist of student learning experiences.
